



Anders Tjellström, M.D., Ph.D., D.Sc.hc

Dr Tjellström got his medical education at the University of Göteborg, SWEDEN. In 1972 he joined professor Brånemark and his research has had a focus on the clinical applications of osseointegrated implants. Together with professor Bo Håkansson at Chalmers university of Technology introduced the bone anchored hearing aid, BAHA. In close cooperation with Kerstin Bergström at Sahlgrenska Academy introduced the concept of bone anchored cranio-facial prostheses.

He has been giving lectures on the BAHA and participated in numerous workshops and today more than 140.000 patients worldwide have been fitted with the BAHA.

He has published more than 150 scientific papers mainly in the field of osseointegration and BAHA.

He has been awarded an Honorary Doctors degree from Chalmers University of Technology.
